Box 4 Fire Buff Association, Inc. is a nonprofit organization operated entirely by volunteers offering rehabilitation services to the City of Dallas Public Safety Departments and surrounding jurisdictions.

Since 1963, the volunteers of Box 4 have been providing rehabilitation services to the working men and women of Dallas. Responding 24/7, volunteers provide firefighters, police and other public safety members a refuge from the incident they are working.



Box 4 plays an integral part to the Dallas Fire Rescue first response protocol. When notified or requested, volunteers respond to a working incident providing a secure and stable place for the working men and women to rehabilitate.

Operating out of a customized rehab canteen with the DFR

designation 896, volunteers provide water, electrolyte drinks, coffee, and snacks. Meals are provided for longer duration events. Misting fans and other devices are made available for cooling workers in hot weather and gas heaters are provided in cold weather. Portable chairs are also

provided at the events. Once recuperated, public safety members can return back to the incident fully rejuvenated and ready to work.

Box 4 responds to 2 alarm or greater fires and other emergencies in the Dallas area. Box 4 volunteers also respond to SWAT incidents, train derailments, plane crashes at Love Field and DFW Airport, Hazmat operations, major public safety events, and Dallas Fire Rescue's Urban Search and Rescue Team events. Box 4 has also provided services to Storm Water, Streets, Water/Sewer, Traffic, and other City of Dallas departments when requested.



Box 4's basic operations are funded solely by donations with the majority of donations coming from fire fighters and surrounding agencies. Maintenance and vehicle liability is provided by the Salvation Army.
